The Extern Experience

STEM Externs complete a rich, three-week summer training that combines professional development and an on-site externship placement with one of our STEM industry partners. The externship experience provides valuable insight into 21st century skills needed in the modern STEM workplace, while interactive curriculum design workshops help Externs translate those real-world experiences into problem-based lessons aligned to the NGSS and Common Core. Follow-up sessions during the school year provide opportunities for ongoing collaboration and reflection with your cohort.

Program Eligibility & Benefits

The STEM Externship opportunity is currently open to 4th and 5th grade teachers, and middle or high school math, science, and CTE teachers from WABS' member districts. Interested teachers must complete the online application located at wabsalliance.org. Applicants will also be interviewed by WABS staff.

Externs receive up to 98.5 free STEM clock hours and a \$1,500 stipend.
